Acrylic paints:

Any funky color that suits your fancy, here are some suggestions;

Metallics of various colors

Titanium White

Yellow ocher

Burnt sienna

Burnt umber

yellow

Bright Red

Alizarin crimson

Magenta

Permanent Rose

Ultramarine blue

Phthalo blue

Phthalo green

“Masterson Stay-wet” Palette with sponge and a sheet of *Stay-wet palette paper (*OR Styrofoam plates to be used as a palette)

Pallet knife (metal and trowel shaped)

Bristol brushes in various shapes and sizes

Container for water (a large plastic water cup or a glass jar work well)

Paper towels (shop towels are especially nice)

Spray bottle

Gel Medium, gloss medium, matte medium, modeling paste, gesso

Old credit cards

Rubbing alcohol

Optional: Gloves (we get messy) or Liquid glove lotion

Optional:

Kitchen spices with a strong color like: saffron, turmeric, cinnamon, unused coffee grounds.

Iridescent medium, glass bead texture, clear gesso, ink, collage materials that will not rot (dried flowers, cloth, tissue or fancy papers..)
