- Sketchbook 11 x 14, one that lays flat*
- White Plastic eraser*
- Kneaded eraser*
- Graphite pencils, variety of hard and soft (4h, 2h, h, HB, 2b, 4b, 6b) Mechanical pencil ok for somethings as well.*
- Pencil sharpener*
- Large and Small white plastic "Click erasers"
- *clear Ruler with thin red gridlines (inches)
- *T-Square
- Tape, non stick artists' tape is best but any will do
- Tracing paper (Hobby Lobby has the most transparent and least expensive)
- Workable Spray fixative
- Graphite sticks: 4b, 6b
- Blending sticks (paper)
- Jumbo vine charcoal
- package of Extra Soft Vine charcoal
- Charcoal pencils (2b, 4b, 6b)
- Images you would like to draw, must have good tonal value ranges.
- *Small (dark) matte board, 8 x 10 with 5 x 7 opening (for making fast/easy borders)
- *Proportional divider
