And any other vivid colors you would like to bring

-Pallet (preferably glass)

-Xacto scraper (for glass pallets)

-Painters' protective lotion such as "Invisible glove", "Liquid glove"

-Pallet knives (metal and trowel shaped, small and flexible are best)

Optional - Small Bristol brushes in various shapes and sizes

-Paper towels (shop towels are especially nice)

-Gessoed Masonite panels (two coats of Liquitex Gesso on smooth side. Home Depot or Lowe's will cut down a 4'x8' piece to any size. I recommend 12"x16", you can get 24 panels from one board) OR Canvas boards
