

# Supply list “Charcoal Drawing Class”

- Willow or vine Charcoal, various sizes, soft, extra soft
- 1 jumbo of the above
- (optional) Nitram Charcoal, Expensive, but wonderful for controlled modeling of values and detail
- Charcoal pencils HB, 2B, 6B
- Paper stumps small, medium and extra large
- Kneaded eraser
- White click erasers (large and small)
- White plastic eraser
- Sketchbook, or drawing paper, anything that says “Charcoal” or “Mixed media” on it. 14x17 or larger (11x14 will also do)  
Pastel/Charcoal paper (white) is fine, but it has a texture you will have to overcome.
- Sandpaper block
- Razor, large (rectangular blade used in utility knife)
- Large drawing board (at least 18x24 or larger)
- Artist’s Tape
- Fixative, Workable and \*Final matte
- Clean empty container with lid, like a salsa bar cup, it’s for storing powdered charcoal
- Clean (never used for painting) Bristol/hog hair brush(s): good shapes are a large round, fan, medium sized filberts
- Proportional divider (Amazon)
