## Level 1

- Vine Charcoal ~ hard, medium, soft (preferably “Nitram” brand)
- Sandpaper ~ smooth and medium
- Paper “stump”blenders, various sizes
- kneaded eraser & hard white plastic eraser
- Charcoal paper 12x18 (large single sheets can be torn into several piece, or you can get pads).
- Tracing paper 11x14 &/or bigger (Hobby Lobby has the most transparent tracing paper I have found, get the thinnest, clearest paper possible)
- Artists’ tape
- Drawing board at least 20x24 (no clips)
- Plumb lines ~ Thick black string with a weight & Thin knitting needle/skewer
- Paper towels
- Utility Knife (box cutter)
- HB pencil (or mechanical)
- \* Optional: Mahl stick, Charcoal holder, black mirror, old brushes
- Small lidded container for saving charcoal dust.
